

- b) The **Women's affairs committee** shall assist the Board of Directors to prepare, organize and distribute free vegetarian meals for the people in need, visitors of the temple, seniors home and the devotees of the Society. They shall formulate guidelines and implement policies beneficial to the women's wing to increase the female memberships. This committee shall be led by a woman.
- c) The **Land, Property and Fundraising committee** shall be responsible for the upkeep of the Society's assets and assist the Board of Directors in all its efforts for the efficient operation of the Society. They should plan, discuss and implement ways and means to raise funds.
- d) The **Special committee** members shall be responsible for general maintenance of the premises. Organizing and arranging Hindu festivals and ceremonies. They also will be responsible for the publication and publicity.

Article IX: Advisors

1. There shall be four(4) advisors selected at the Board of Director's meeting for a continuous period of two (2) years or until he/she resigns.
2. The advisors of the Society shall be appointed at the first meeting of the Board of Directors. These members need not necessarily have served as a member of the Board of Directors in the past.
3. The Advisors shall deal with the properties of the Society with the Board of Directors.
4. The Advisors shall suggest the Board of Directors in control and management of the affairs, properties and funds against all risks and expenses by the Society.
5. The Advisors shall advise the Board of Directors to improve the Society.

Article X: The Society Chief Priest

1. The Priest mean a Hindu Priest, who is qualified to perform, inter alia, temple festivals, ceremonies, and rites in accordance with the Hindu Religion.
2. The Society Chief priest would be vested with the responsibilities of the religious matters, and he is responsible for the Society ornaments and utensils. He shall keep the Society's valuable ornaments in a safe Locker. A list of such ornaments shall be provided to the President and Treasurer.
3. The Priest shall be allowed to carryout any religious functions outside the Society for his own account without any disruption to the regular and normal good functioning of the Society. The priest shall give notice to the President and secretary when he would be engaged in such outside functions. The priest shall arrange for his replacement when he is engaged in such outside functions.
4. The administration of the Society would be vested with the Board of Directors governing the Society.

Article XI: Change in By- Law

The By-Laws of the Society shall not be altered except by special resolution. A Majority vote of not less than 75% of the members present in person at a meeting called for this purpose is required.
